PROCLAMATION

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Friedreich's ataxia is a degenerative neurological disease that leads to loss of coordination, loss of ability to walk and, ultimately, to fatal heart disease; and

WHEREAS, This inherited disease typically emerges in childhood and often affects several children within the same family; and

WHEREAS, There is currently no cure or effective treatment for Friedreich's ataxia, but Indianapolis-based research is developing a promising new treatment for this and similar diseases; and

WHEREAS, Jumpin' for Jazz is an Indianapolis-based non-profit organization dedicated to improving the lives of children suffering from Friedreich's ataxia, ensuring quality care for all and empowering research organizations to find the cure; and

WHEREAS, The Jumpin' for Jazz 5K Walk for Those Who Can't takes place Saturday, April 30, 2016, at Broad Ripple Park.

THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH H. HOGSETT, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF INDIANAPOLIS, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM APRIL 30, 2016, AS:
